The Transfiguration of Jesus

The Transfiguration of Christ is one of the Great Feasts of the Orthodox Church, celebrated on August 6.

Jesus had gone with his disciples Peter, James, and John to Mount Tabor. Christ's appearance was changed while they watched into a glorious radiant figure. There appeared Elijah and Moses, speaking with Jesus. The disciples were amazed and terribly afraid.

This event shows forth the divinity of Christ, so that the disciples would understand after his Ascension that He was truly the radiant splendor of the Father, and that his Passion was voluntary (Mark 9:2-9). It also shows the possibility of our own theosis.

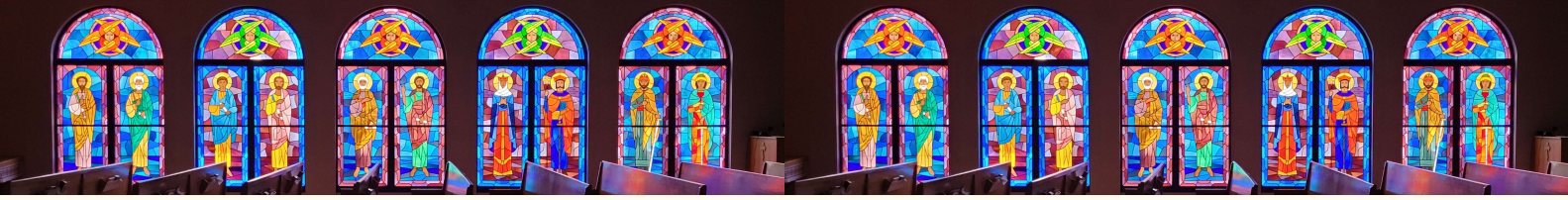
This event was the subject of some debates between Gregory Palamas and Barlaam of Calabria. Barlaam believed that the light shining from Jesus was created light, while Gregory maintained the disciples were given grace to perceive the uncreated light of God. This supported Gregory's larger argument that although we cannot know God in His essence, we can know Him in his energies, as He reveals Himself.

Accounts of the Transfiguration are found in the Bible: Matthew 17:1-8, Mark 9:2-9, Luke 9:28-36, and II Peter 1:16-19.

Celebration of the feast

Like all feasts of the Master, the Transfiguration is a vigil-ranked feast, though in parish practice a full All-Night Vigil is usually not celebrated. Typically, Great Vespers is conducted on the eve of the feast, and on the morning of the feast, the Divine Liturgy of Saint John Chrysostom celebrated, traditionally preceded by the Matins service.

The Vespers service includes the readings: Exodus 24:12-18, 33:11-23, 34:4-6, 8; I Kings 19:3-9, 11-13, 15-16. The Matins service includes the reading: Luke 9:28-36. And the Divine Liturgy: II Peter 1:10-19; Matthew 17:1-9.



The Transfiguration of Jesus continued

It is believed that Christ's transfiguration took place at the time of the Jewish Festival of Booths, and that the celebration of the event in the Christian Church became the New Testament fulfillment of the Old Testament feast. Presently it is celebrated on the sixth of August, forty days before the feast, Elevation of the Holy Cross. Just as Peter, James, and John saw the transfiguration before the crucifixion so that they might know who it is who will suffer for them, the Church connects these two feasts to help the faithful understand the mission of Christ and that his suffering was voluntary.

The feast of the Transfiguration of Christ once belonged to the season of Great Lent but may have been considered too joyous for that time. Saint Gregory Palamas, a great teacher of the Transfiguration, is now celebrated on one of the Sundays of Lent instead.

Traditions

In Greece and Romania, the harvest season traditionally began on the Transfiguration. Grapes, in particular, were not eaten before August 6. In some parishes, the first grapes would be brought to church for a blessing and distributed to parishioners.

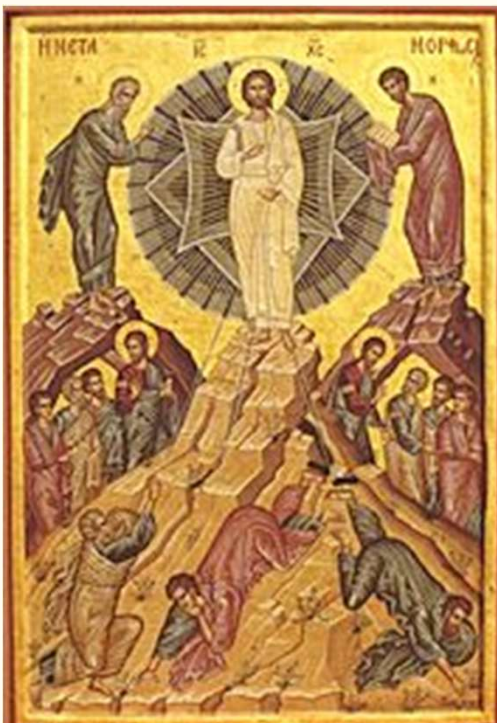

Thank you to those that came out on June 6 to complete a few of the cleanup task! However, a few more tasks remain. Consequently, your assistance is still required! Please come to the Parish to assist on

Saturday June 27, 2026, commencing at 1pm, weather permitting

The cleanup tasks still required to be completed include:

- Pick up debris around entire yard
- Sweeping up of gravel from the parking lot
- Install fencing around front flower garden
- Wash ground level main entrance door windows
- Prune branches around south parking lot lamps and along pathway
- Pick weeds in south window well and at gas meter
- Clear leaves from SE corner of South parking lot
- Garbage cans with gravel to be moved to locked storage at rear entrance



This list is smaller than it was last month but is still ambitious! Please bring tools to help make the afternoon most fruitful – pails, dust pans, push brooms, brooms, gas-powered blowers, fuel, tree trimmers, branch loppers, hand pruners, etc.

Keeping yourself safe is a necessity, too, so please also bring gloves, knee pads, coveralls, dust masks, drinking water, etc.

The cleanup will occur unless it is actively raining. Coffee and donuts will be provided!

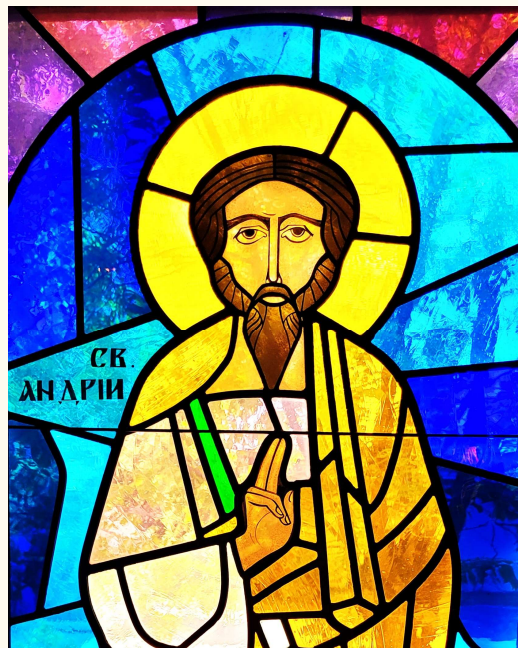

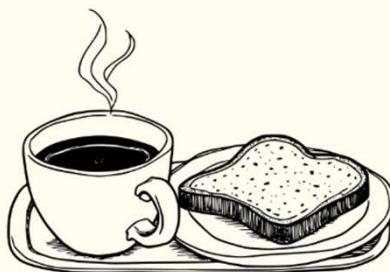
Fellowship, 2025-2026

Great Prince St. Volodymyr**

On July 28 on the Gregorian Calendar (which is July 15 on the Julian) we celebrate the Baptizer of Kyivan Rus' the Great Knyaz' Volodymyr, who, like his grandmother, St. Ol'ha, is titled "Equal-to-the Apostles" (Ukrainian "Rivnoapostol'nyy", Greek "Isapostolos"). This great man was chosen by God to play a key role in the unfolding destiny of the Ukrainian, Belarus and Russian nations, among others



**Dormition (Falling Asleep)
of the Theotokos**

The Dormition (Falling Asleep) of the Theotokos is one of the Great Feasts of the Orthodox Church, celebrated on August 15. The Feast of the Dormition, which is also sometimes called the Assumption, commemorates the death, resurrection and glorification of Christ's mother. It proclaims that Mary has been "assumed" by God into the heavenly kingdom of Christ in the fullness of her spiritual and bodily existence.
