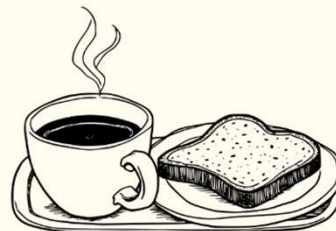

ST. ANDREW'S MENS CLUB By Ernest N. Skakun, President

Dear Honorary Members, Members, Associate Members and Friends of the Parish,

On behalf of St. Andrew's Mens Club (SAMC) Board of Directors, I greet all of you, once again, with the hope that you have had an enjoyable and relaxing summer.

Social and Appreciation Events. The Club's next Social Event is the **Annual Salmon Supper**, which will be held on **Monday, September 21**. (See the attached Poster). Once again, I encourage those who have attended the event on a regular basis to bring a guest (or guests), preferably a recent arrival from Ukraine who attends worship services but is not a member of either the Parish, the Ladies Auxiliary, or the Mens Club. Let us extend a welcoming hand!

SAMC is planning an appreciation event for the volunteers that have helped with working bingos and casinos. Such an appreciation was held last fall. Once the date and venue are determined Gordon Ostapchuk (Bingo Chair) and Lawrence Dary (Casino Chair) will contact the volunteers and extend an invitation.

Vacancy. The position of Vice-President remains vacant. If you are a SAMC member, please consider serving on the Board of Directors. It is absolutely necessary that the position is filled.

Membership. The numerous requests for male members of the Parish to become members of SAMC has not been all that successful. Once again, I make the plea. It is essential to increase the membership for the following reasons.

- **Succession planning.** The majority of the Executive and Directors have served repeated terms in their positions and often holding two positions simultaneously. It is time for others to step in.
- **Financial stability.** The proceeds from Bingos are about \$50,000 annually; proceeds from a casino are about \$80,000 every two years. SAMC and the Parish are fortunate in having conscientious Bingo and Casino chairs and a small dedicated group of Parish volunteers to help staff the two gaming fund-raisers. However, there have been times in the past years, when bingo events had to be shared with another club due to an insufficient number of volunteers. In such instances, SAMC shared the proceeds 50/50 with the other club. For the period 2018-2025, SAMC has donated \$420,000 to the Parish. To maintain the regular annual donation (\$50,000) to the Parish requires a viable Mens Club with a sufficiently larger number of members than at present.

Once again, this is not a message of doom and gloom; it is a message of reality.

WHAT DOES THE NAME “SOBOR” MEAN?

By the decision of His Eminence, Metropolitan Ilarion, St. Anthony’s Ukrainian Orthodox Parish is being elevated to the dignity of “*Sobor*” on July 12, 2026. What does this mean? In the Orthodox Church there are various designations for places of worship and their associated communities. In North America, most Orthodox communities begin their formation by meeting for worship in irregular and various places – in community halls, private homes, rented facilities, etc. At this point of their genesis, these Orthodox communities normally bear the status of “*Mission*.”

As the community grows, matures and establishes itself more fully, and upon demonstrating definite stability as a functioning parish, and especially after a permanent temple has been built or purchased, the status of this community changes to that of a “*parish*.” This is the most common form of community status in the Orthodox Church.

Some local communities in larger cities, or major Metropolitan centres, eventually go on to become elevated to the status of “*Cathedral*” parishes. A “*Cathedral*” church is the main church of the Eparchy, where the ruling Bishop typically presides at important Liturgies. The Cathedral church is located in the administrative city of the Eparchy. A “*Cathedral*” gets its name from the fact that the Bishop’s Throne or “*cathedra*” (a Greek word meaning “*chair*” or “*throne*”), is located in that temple. The Bishop *sits* on this “*cathedra*” when presiding over Hierarchal Divine Services. In addition to the Eparchial Cathedral, where the throne of the ruling Bishop is, there are also Auxiliary Cathedrals. These Auxiliary Cathedrals are other churches within the Eparchy. In some cases, the Eparchial Bishop’s assistant Bishop (or assistant Bishops) are situated in these auxiliary cathedrals.

In the Orthodox Church, especially in the Slavic tradition, there are two types of Cathedral parishes – “*Cathedral’nyj Sobors*” and regular “*Sobors*.” As mentioned above, the “*Cathedral – Cathedral’nyj Sobor*” is the Eparchial or Auxiliary Bishop’s main church where he is centered and serves most often. On the other hand, regular Sobors (where the Bishop is not normally centered), are churches in promoting the faith, appropriate architectural or iconographic adherence, as well as other determining factors.

The Parish community of the Venerable Anthony of the Kyiv Caves, is honoured to have its Temple and community elevated to the status of “*Sobor*” by His Eminence, Metropolitan Ilarion. We pray that our Sobor community will continue to lead its faithful in constant glorification of our Risen Lord, God and Saviour Jesus Christ and unto the eternal salvation of their souls!

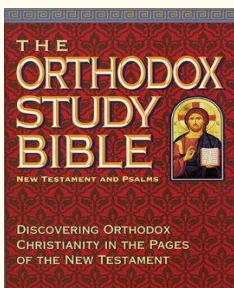




The Nativity of the Theotokos

The Nativity of the Theotokos is one of the Great Feasts of the Orthodox Church, celebrated on September 8. The Holy Virgin and Theotokos Mary was born to elderly and previously barren parents by the names of Joachim and Anna, in answer to their prayers. The Orthodox believe that the Nativity of the Most-Holy Theotokos represents an integral part of God's Plan aimed at the salvation of the fallen human race. The epistle reading is from Philippians 2:5-11, and speaks of "Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men." The gospel reading is taken from Luke 10:38-42 and 11:27-28 together; this reading is also always read on all feasts of the Theotokos. In it, the Lord says, "blessed are those who hear the word of God and keep it!"

The Exaltation of the Holy Cross September 14

This feast commemorates two events: The finding of the Cross by the Empress Helen (the mother of St. Constantine the Great) on Golgotha in 326 AD, the place where Christ was crucified, and the recovery of the Cross on which Jesus Christ was crucified from the Persians. The Persians had captured the True Cross as a prize of war when they sacked Jerusalem in 614 AD.

This is a holy day of fasting and repentance. On this day the faithful make dedication to the crucified Lord and pledge their faithfulness to him by making prostrations at the Lord's feet on the life creating Cross. For the feast, the Cross is placed on a tray surrounded by flowers or branches of basil and placed in the center of the Church for veneration.
